

TROOP 171

Voluntary Return to Troop 171 Activities

As a condition of resuming Troop 171 in-person activities, parents/guardians must execute and abide by this form documenting the parents/guardians' voluntary decision to permit their child to resume on-site, in person activities. While Troop 171 will implement reasonable management and control measures in accordance with applicable Commonwealth of Virginia and County of Spotsylvania health guidance to mitigate the risk of COVID-19 transmission, it gives no guaranty, express or implied, that such transmission will not occur. A list of the Troop 171 Procedures for Meeting In-Person has been previously provided to you and is subject to amendment given the potential for changing circumstances. **Notwithstanding the foregoing, Troop 171's risk management measures are not a guaranty that transmission of COVID-19 will not occur at in-person Troop meetings. Parents/guardians are responsible for taking reasonable measures to mitigate risk to their child(ren) or that their child(ren) may present to the health of others when on Troop Activities.**

Please carefully read and review the following:

1. I/We, _____ (parent/guardian's full name), hereby give my child(ren) _____ (child's full name), permission to participate in all Troop in-person 171 Activities.
2. I/We agree to monitor my child(ren)'s health and not allow him/her to participate in Troop 171 in-person activities if he has a fever at or above 100.4 degrees, cough, fatigue, or other physical symptoms that require observation, health isolation, or medical treatment.
3. I/We agree not to send our child to a Troop 171 Activity if anyone in our residence is currently a patient under investigation (PUI) or quarantine or if the Scout has been in close contact with a person who has been tested for, or diagnosed with, or quarantined as a result of COVID-19. Additionally, I/We agree not to send our Scout to a meeting or Troop Activity until the Rappahannock Area Health Department (RAHD) has indicated that it is safe to do so.
4. I/We consent and understand that Troop 171 may take my child's temperature before and during a Troop Activity. If my child has a fever of 100.4 or above, he will be isolated, parent/legal guardian will be contacted, and the child must be picked up by a parent or legal guardian within one hour.
5. If my child is sent home, he cannot return to the Troop Activity for 72 hours from the day he is sent home, and upon return, must be symptom-free and fever-free without medication.

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6. I/We agree to accept the management and control measures taken by Troop 171 in accordance with state and local guidance to reduce the spread of COVID-19.
7. I/We understand that Troop 171 cannot guarantee safety for all Scouts or prevent them from contracting any illness.
8. I/We certify that we have not been on a plane for the 14 days prior to a Troop Activity.
9. I/We certify that no one in the residence has tested positive for COVID-19, and that if they have previously, they have been re-tested and cleared by the RAHD as able to return to work/school.

By voluntarily allowing my child(ren) to participate in Troop 171 Activities, I/We hereby acknowledge and agree that I/We am/are assuming the risk of my child(ren) or myself possibly contracting COVID-19. Further, I/We acknowledge and agree that on my/our behalf and on behalf of my/our child(ren) I/We am/are voluntarily waiving any claim of liability against Troop 171 and the Eastland United Methodist Church should my child(ren) or I contract COVID-19 as a result of participating in a Troop 171 Activity. Further, I expressly agree to hold Troop 171 and Eastland United Methodist Church harmless should I/We and/or my/our child(ren) contract COVID-19 as result of our voluntary participation in a Troop 171 Activity.
